CONTEST OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. PURCHASING PRODUCTS OR SERVICES FROM CALIFORNIA COAST CREDIT UNION WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. EACH ENTRY HAS AN EQUAL CHANCE OF WINNING. The "Dash for Cash Promotion" (Contest) begins 9:00 AM Pacific Daylight Time (PDT) on November 10, 2024, and ends 11:00 PM PDT on March 15, 2025 (Contest Period). By entering this Contest, entrants accept and agree to be bound by these Official Rules. Contest void where prohibited by law. California Coast Credit Union (California Coast) is the sponsor of this Contest (Sponsor).

WHO MAY ENTER: Entrants must be at least 18 years of age, have valid government issued identification and valid tax identification number. California Coast employees, officials, and members of their immediate families are not eligible to participate in the Contest. Business entities are not eligible to participate. Contest is void in Puerto Rico, U.S. territories and possessions outside of the United States, and where restricted or prohibited by law.

HOW TO ENTER: Eligible entrants must fill out form on Cal Coast website to be entered into the opportunity drawing. Eligible entrants may enter this Contest via the Cal Coast website or Mail. By entering the contest entrants accepts being contacted by either phone or email. The entry methods are described below. All entries must be received by 5:00 PM PST, March 15, 2025. Online Entry Method: Eligible entrants must fill out form on Cal Coast website to be entered into the opportunity drawing. Alternative Method of Entry (AMOE): Mail a 3" x 5" card with, your first name, last name, complete address, city, state, zip code, home phone number (including area code) and email address (if any) to "Dash for Cash Promotion" c/o California Coast Credit Union, Attn: Community Relations Dept., PO Box 502080, San Diego, CA 92150-2080. California Coast will not verify receipt of entries for entrants. All entries submitted become the sole property of California Coast and will not be returned. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, illegible, or damaged AMOE entries. All AMOE entries must be received by 9:00 AM PST, March 15, 2025 to qualify.

Prize/Approximate Retail Value: First place winner will receive up to \$500 in cash along with four (4) tickets to a designated Gulls game. The Approximate Retail Value (the "ARV") of the four (4) Gulls tickets is \$240. Based upon California Coast's estimate of 750 entries, the odds of winning any prize are 1 chance in 750. Prize is not transferrable.

Selection of Winners: One (1) winner will be chosen on each of the following days: Saturday, November 30, Saturday, December 28, Wednesday, January 15, Wednesday, February 19, Wednesday, March 26, Wednesday, April 16. The entry that is randomly selected by a random number generator will be selected as the winner and will receive four (4) Gulls tickets at the Pechanga Arena on preselected dates. A panel of representatives from the Sponsor will judge the entries and resolve any disputes that may arise during the contest. All decisions by the panel are final. The winner will be contacted via phone and email. If Sponsor is unable to contact the prospective winner within 24 hours of being contacted, or if the prospective winner does not meet eligibility qualifications, his/her prize will be forfeited and an alternate prospective winner shall be selected. The cash prize must be picked up at the California Coast Credit Union branch nearest to the winner between the hours of 9:00am-5:00pm. The tickets to the Gulls game will be sent virtually, via the AXS app. The winner will be asked to identify their first and last name via email and will then be asked for proof of identification upon receiving prize.

Liability/General Rules: California Coast is not responsible for any loss which may occur in connection with the "Dash for Cash Promotion." Entrants agree to hold California Coast harmless from any liability arising from participation in the Contest or the acceptance, receipt, possession, or misuse of the prize. California Coast and each of its officers, directors, employees, members, representatives and agents are not responsible for any negligence, claims, liability, injury, property loss, or other damages of entrants and/or winners arising from, or in connection with, acceptance, receipt, possession, or use/misuse of prizes awarded or participation in the "Dash for Cash Promotion." Arbitration: Except where prohibited by law, as a condition of participating in this Contest, entrant agrees that (1) any and all disputes and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Contest or any prizes awarded, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively, by final and binding arbitration under the rules of the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") and shall be held at the AAA regional office nearest the participant; (2) the Federal Arbitration Act shall govern the interpretation, enforcement, and all proceedings at such arbitration; and (3) judgment upon such arbitration award may be entered in any court having jurisdiction.
